Collage	Collage describes both the technique and the resulting work of art in which pieces of paper, photographs, fabric and other ephemera are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface.
texture	How a surface feels to the touch.
fold	Bend something flat over on itself.
crumple	Crush a material so it becomes creased.
overlap	Cover the edge of a material.
tear	Rip carefully.
arrange	Order, lay out in an attractive order.
